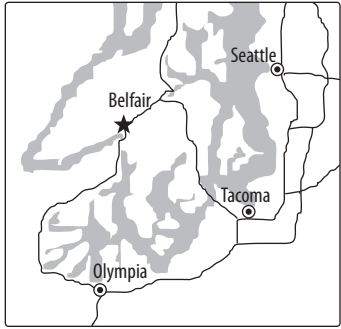


Department and Community

Mason County Fire District No. 2 is centered in Belfair, WA, and covers approximately 100 square miles. MCFD2 responded to over 1700 alarms in 2007. Operating out of 6 stations, MCFD2 has 4 engines, 2 medic units, 1 command unit, 2 tenders and 2 brush trucks.

Belfair is situated on Hood Canal, just 10 miles south of Bremerton, and 45 minutes West of Tacoma. The area is primarily rural and residential



(approximately 12,000 local residents), with small pockets of commercial and industrial activity.

Belfair has two elementary schools, a junior high

and a high school, a public library, community center, nature trails, retail shops, banks, medical practitioners, and more. Public boat ramps and two State Parks are within 10 minutes of downtown. Just 15 minutes away, Tahuya National Forest offers recreational opportunities with hundreds of miles of horse, bike and ORV trails open year-round.

(LIVE-IN AVAILABLE BUT NOT REQUIRED)

Status: Volunteer (no wages or rights of contract)

Stipend of \$200-\$500 per month.

Assigned to one of three shifts, working a 48 on and 96 off schedule.

Department Provided Training:

- Recruit Academy or equivalent (this requirement is waived if applicant is currently certified as an IFSAC Firefighter I or has a degree in Fire Science).
- EMS: EMT certification, IV Technician, BLS Technician, ALS Assistant, Ambulance Operator.
- EVAP, Pumper School, Engine Driver, Tender Driver, Brush Truck Driver
- Wildland FF 2, FF 1, Squad Boss
- Off Road Vehicle Rescue Team Member
- Extrication Training

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Eighteen (18) years of age upon appointment.

High school graduate (or equivalent)

Valid Washington State Driver's License and acceptable driving record

Physically and mentally capable of performing the functions of a firefighter

Job Duties

Resident* Volunteer Firefighters are responsible for work performed in combating, extinguishing, and preventing fires and protection of life and property through firefighting, public education, fire prevention, and other emergency service activities. Duties also include other support services under close supervision of a duty officer.

Application Process

- Application packets for program participation may be obtained by calling Captain Scott Cooper at 360-275-6711, or in person during regular business hours at Fire Station 21 at 460 NE Old Belfair Hwy in Belfair. You may visit our website at www.mcfd2.com and obtain a downloadable application and mail it to PO Box 277, Belfair, WA 98528 c/o Captain Cooper.
- Completed application packets received by the District Office will be screened to determine if the applicant meets minimum requirements and training. Incomplete applications will be rejected, so please read and follow directions carefully. Qualified applicants will be ranked based on experience and education. Preference may be given to applicants with previous volunteer experience and/or current enrollment in a local college majoring in Fire Science, Fire Command/Administration, or Public Administration.
- Applicants WITHOUT REQUIRED TRAINING, but available for regular volunteer participation and a long-term commitment (minimum of two years after training successfully completed) may be chosen to participate in a District-sponsored recruit academy and EMS certificate program. Applicants must request this special consideration in their letter of interest.
- Qualified applicants will be required to participate in a physical agility test.
- Qualified applicants may be invited to participate in an oral interview by the Fire Chief or designee.
- Each candidate must complete and pass a physical exam and background check.
- Positions may be filled from the list of qualified applicants as they are received.
